

Joe Snow Memorial Bass Tournament
Rules and Regulations
Launch: Safe Light April 25, 2009

1. Must be at least 16 years of age and/or be accompanied by a person 18 years or older and have parent's or guardian's signature.
 2. This is a buddy tournament or you may fish alone at same entry fee.
 3. Any participant who fails to sign release of liability form will NOT be allowed to fish.
 4. Safe boating conduct will be observed AT ALL TIMES.
 5. Each competitor is required to wear a Coast Guard approved P.F.D while operating gas engine.
 6. NO alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed during tournament hours. Violators will be disqualified.
 7. Interpretation of these rules will be exclusively to the tournament officials.
 8. Only largemouth, smallmouth or spotted bass will be weighed.
 9. Largemouth and spotted bass must be 15 inches or more, smallmouth at least 18 inches or more measured with mouth closed and tails can be fanned or pinched while measuring.
 10. Golden rule will be the official measuring board used.
 11. Measurement of fish by tournament officials only.
 12. FIVE (5) fish limit per boat.
 13. Only artificial lures may be used. Exception being prepared pork trailers.
 14. One rod and reel may be used at a time with an 8 foot maximum length.
 15. Trolling is not permitted.
 16. Live wells WILL be checked by tournament officials prior to start of the tournament.
 17. Late penalty will be 1 pound per minute late. Disqualification after 15 minutes late.
 18. Two (2) ounce penalty for each dead fish.
 19. Maximum two (2) people per boat.
 20. Competition waters to only include Barkley and Kentucky lakes. ALL state boating and fishing regulations will apply.
 21. Officials have the right to delay launch due to fog or inclement weather. Check-in will remain at 3:00pm.
