**Subject: Sign Ordinance**

With another election year approaching we would like to let the business community aware that the sign ordinance related to election signs has been changed.

If an election sign is posted on commercial property, a permit is required. The permit can be obtained at our office and applicable fees will be applied. Permits are not required for parcels dedicated to single-family residential use. Signs on residential properties shall be 6 square feet or less. Signs are not permissible on vacant residential lots. All zones other than single family residential zones require proper permitting, with respect to the requirement of designated zoning.

In accordance with City Ordinance 33-2005-06 all sign permits are issued at a cost of \$25.00 per sign. Any signs placed in public right-of-ways or mounted on utility poles will be confiscated and destroyed.
