

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How to bring in necessary items to inmates?

If the inmate is incarcerated and has been facility for less than 24 hours these items may be brought in a paper bag only.

3 white t-shirts

3 white underwear (boxers or briefs)

3 white socks

2 towels (any color except white)

Up to 3 magazines or paperback books and a religious book

If inmate needs medication from home it has to be in that prescription bottle with the inmates name on that bottle for that prescription only.

Phone Service for Inmates

Global Tel Link is the telephone provider for the inmates

All phone calls are collect and they are \$1.50 per call (15 minutes minimum)

Bonding Procedures

Corporate Bond – Go through a bondsman

Cash Bond – You pay your bond in full with cash

Property Bond – Two people with two separate pieces of property who go to the clerks office with proof (deed, tax paper, ext) they own the property.

Directions to Montgomery County Jail

From I-24 West

Take the US-79 exit 4 toward Clarksville/Ft. Campbell

Turn left onto US-79 S/Wilma Rudolph Blvd/TN-13S.

Continue to follow US-79 S/Tn-13 S.

US-79 S/TN-13 S becomes College St/TN-48

Turn left onto University Ave/US-41A/TN-112/N 6th Street

End at 116 Commerce Street.
