

## **THE FOLLOWING LIST OF ITEMS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED INSIDE THE JAIL**

**HANDBAGS   CELL PHONES   PURSES   CIGARETTES   LIGHTERS**

- Magazines & books will be exchanged on a basis of one for one.
- Up to three magazines may be exchanged on Saturday & Sunday.
- Magazines, which are in any way shape or form, found to be gang related, obscene, vulgar, depict nudity or violence will not be allowed.
- Any other magazine or books must be approved through Jail Administration.

## **DRESS CODE**

Male visitors will wear pants, worn in such a fashion that no “private” areas of the anatomy are visible. Shorts will not be permitted. Pants worn in a “baggy” fashion, which becomes suggestive will not be permitted.

Female visitors will wear pants or long dresses. Dresses will reach below the knee level. Pants will be worn so that no “private” areas of the anatomy are visible. Female visitors will not be permitted to visit an inmate, while wearing tube tops, tank tops, halter tops, shorts, mini shirts, skirts that are above knee length, dresses that expose shoulders or breast area.

This dress code will apply only to visitors twelve (12) years of age or older. Children under twelve (12) years of age, will still be dressed appropriately.

Any supervisor, or visitation deputy, may deem clothing unfit for visitation. Any visitor who is in violation of this directive, will not be permitted to visit, until they comply with this policy.

# **RULES FOR VISITATION**

1. No shorts, Short Skirts, or Revealing Clothing.
2. Children must remain with Guardian.
3. No Running, Jumping, or Climbing.
4. No Cursing or Yelling.
5. No Obscene Gestures.
6. Must leave when Visit is over.
7. Destruction of County Property will be prosecuted.

Any violation will result in temporary suspension or permanently revoked.
